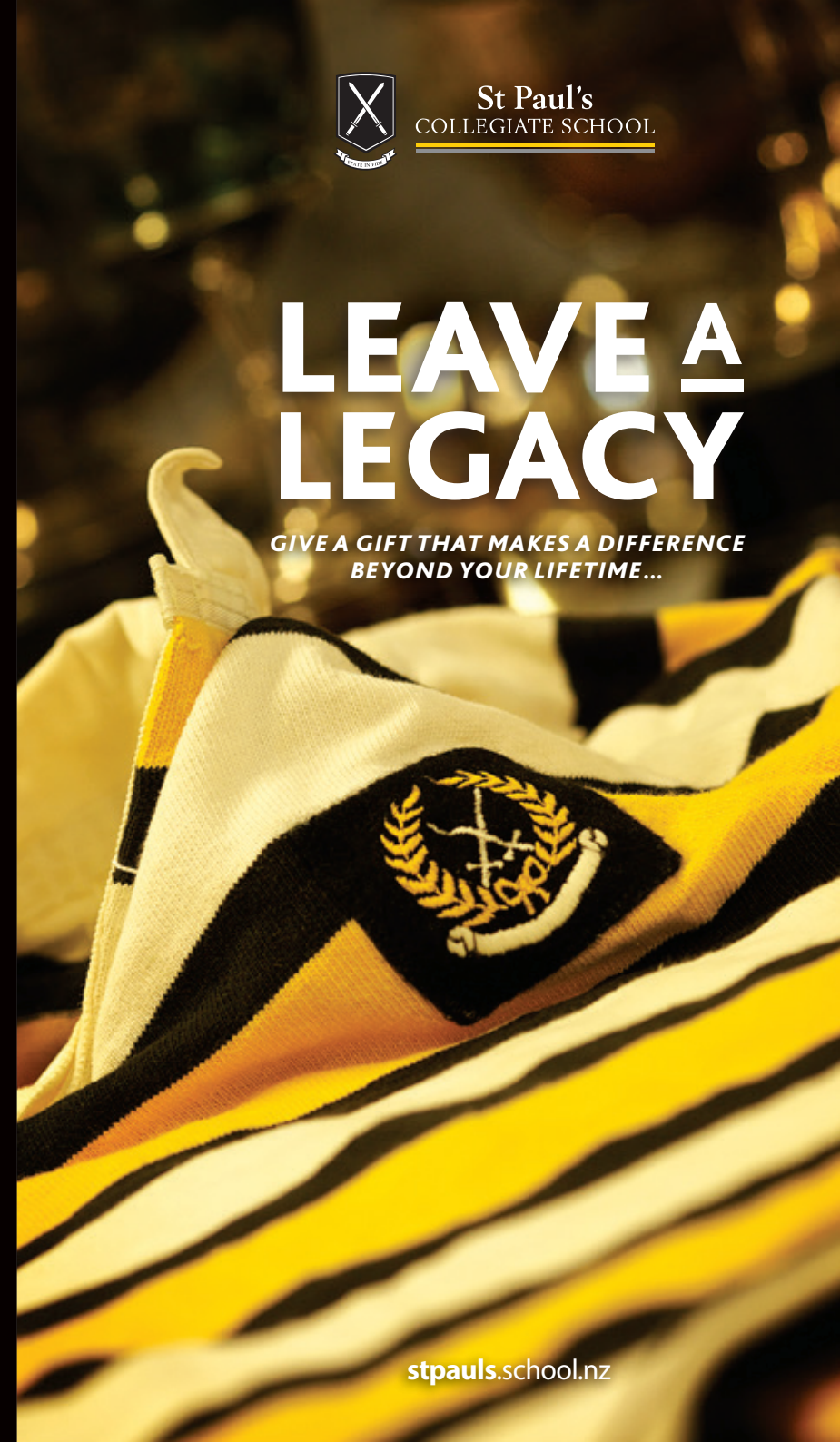

■ BEQUESTS AND ESTATE PLAN GIFTS

A bequest is a gift from your estate – a transfer of cash or other property made through your estate plans. You can make a bequest to St Paul's Collegiate School by including language in your will or by designating St Paul's as a beneficiary of your life insurance policy.

■ WHY REMEMBER ST PAUL'S IN YOUR WILL?

St Paul's Collegiate School has a reputation for turning possibilities into reality – whether in the classroom, on the sports field, on the stage or in the boarding house. The school has a proven record for setting high expectations and getting the best from their students. They are committed to providing a high-class education and developing the next generation of future leaders.

St Paul's as an independent school, gets no funding from the government for developments it may like to undertake to meet the future needs of educating our students. We are also conscious of the need to make the opportunities offered by our school as accessible to as many families as possible.

St Paul's Foundation is the fundraising arm of St Paul's Collegiate School and is dependent on philanthropy to provide financial assistance in the following ways:

Scholarships – To ensure a family's income doesn't stop a worthy teenager from having the opportunity to learn at St Paul's through the Te Amorangi scholarship programme.

■ TYPES OF GIFTS

There are many ways to support St Paul's in your will:

- A pecuniary gift – an exact sum of money or a percentage of your estate
- A residuary gift – the balance of your estate
- A specific gift – a non-monetary legacy, by which you can leave particular assets to St Paul's, for example stocks and shares, life insurance, property, antiques, works of art, or other valuables
- A reversionary gift – a gift which will pass to St Paul's after another named recipient has enjoyed the income during their lifetime
- A conditional gift – a gift which will pass to St Paul's if none of your named beneficiaries survives you.

■ ADVANTAGES OF CREATING A BEQUEST

- A bequest costs nothing now, yet gives you the satisfaction of knowing you have provided for St Paul's in the future
- You retain control of and use of your assets during your lifetime
- You may modify your bequest if your circumstances change
- St Paul's Foundation is a Charitable Trust, so gifts to St Paul's Foundation are tax deductible
